ON DECLARING THE CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS OF THE LAW ON ACCREDITATION

LAW

ON CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS OF THE LAW ON ACCREDITATION

Article 1

In the Law on Accreditation ("Official Gazette", no. 158/03), in the Article 2, the words "specific tasks" are changed into: "conformity assessment activities".

Article 2

In the Article 4 of the Law, behind the item 3 the new item no. 4 is added as follows:

"(4) Accreditation Body shall be a member of the European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) and shall conclude the Multilateral Agreements about mutual recognition of accreditation with the other EA members."

Previous items no. 4, 5 and 6 become the items 5, 6 and 7.

Article 3

In the Article 6 of the Law, the new item number 2 is added as follows:

"(2) Accreditation Body shall not perform any activities or services related to the activities of the conformity assessment bodies for which the accreditation body conducts accreditation activities and grants the accreditation certificates."

Article 4

In front of the Article 8 the title of the chapter is changed as follows: "IV. ACCREDITATION AND CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS".

Article 5

This Law comes into force the eight day after the announcement in the Official Gazette.
